UOG Nursing & Health Sciences Take a Leap Into the Future with Virtual Reality-Powered Training!



The University of Guam's [Nursing and Health Sciences Program](#) has received a high-tech upgrade with the donation of Virtual Reality (VR) headsets, transforming how students prepare for clinical practice. Funded by the [Guam Area Health Education Center \(AHEC\)](#) through the U.S. Department of Labor's Workforce Pathways for Youth Program, the VR tech is part of the [\\$2M PAVE Project—a 3-year initiative](#) promoting healthcare careers for youth ages 14–21 across seven states and territories. The headsets, provided in partnership with [Maui County AHEC](#) and [Hawaii Pacific Basin AHEC](#), offer immersive simulations to help students sharpen critical skills in a safe, realistic environment.


